APPLICANT:

Tahoe City Public Utility District P.O. Box 33 Tahoe City, CA 96145

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.03 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, McKinney Shores, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing water intake pipeline and appurtenant facilities previously authorized by the Commission as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Twenty years, beginning March 13, 2002.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Combined single limit coverage of \$1,000,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

 On March 23, 1982, the Commission authorized a General Permit - Right of Way Use to Tahoe City Public Utility District for the continued use and maintenance of existing water service facilities. The lease expired on March 12, 2002. Tahoe City Public Utility District is now applying for a

new General Lease - Right of Way Use.

2.
