REQUESTS AUTHORITY FOR EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003-2004

PROPOSED ACTIVITY

The Executive Officer requests authority to execute following interagency agreements for 2003-2004 fiscal year:

1. Department of Justice

Contract No.C2003-001

Enter into an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Justice to provide the Commission legal consultative and investigative services to protect the State's interest within Long Beach tidelands under Chapter 29, Statutes of 1956 1st E.S., Chapter 138 Statutes of 1964 1st E.S., and the Alamitos Bay litigation. Estimated agreement \$100,000.

2. Teale Data Center

Contract No. C2003-003

Enter into an Interagency Agreement with Stephen P. Teale Data Center to provide the Commission telecommunications, Internet access, local area network and system development services, equipment, software and support. Estimated agreement \$120,000.

3. Board of Equalization

Contract No. C2003-004

Enter into an Interagency Agreement with the Board of Equalization (BOE) to perform staff services for the collection of fee specified in Ballast Water Management Act, Chapter 849, Statutes of 1999. The Act specifies certain

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fee collection duties be performed by the BOE. Interagency Agreement is required between the agencies for this purpose. Estimated agreement \$400,000.

All agreements are subject to necessary funding being available in Commission's 2003-04 Budget Act appropriation as approved by Legislature. Necessary agreements shall be prepared consistent with procedures as specified in the State Administrative Manual and Public Contract Code. All documentation will be available for public inspection at the Commission's Sacramento office in accordance with Public Contract Code requirements.
