Darlene A. Brock (Sole Trustee of The Trust of William L. and Darlene A. Brock)

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

.09 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, near the city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing floating boat dock and walkway.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning August 5, 2001.

CONSIDERATION:

\$260 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$500,000 Combined Single Limit.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

 On July 6, 1995, the Commission authorized a General Lease -Recreational Use with Darlene A. Brock (Sole Trustee of the Trust of William L. and Darlene A. Brock). That lease expired on August 5, 2001. Darlene A. Brock is now applying for a new General Lease - Recreational Use. Applicant does not qualify for a rent-free Recreational Pier Lease because a single-family residence is not located on the upland.
