CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE AWARD OF THE CRUDE OIL SALES CONTRACTS TO THE HIGHEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER(S), TRACT NO. 1, LONG BEACH UNIT, WILMINGTON OIL FIELD, LOS ANGELES COUNTY

BACKGROUND:

At its meeting on June 2, 2003, the California State Lands Commission (Commission) authorized the sale by the City of Long Beach (City) of crude oil from Tract No. 1, Long Beach Unit, Wilmington Oil Field, Los Angeles County. At present, the City's share of crude oil from Tract No. 1 is being sold to Edgington Oil Company (7% Segment) and Valero Refining Company California (5 ½% Segment). The oil is being offered in two (2) separate sales contracts: one for seven percent (7%) and a second for five and one-half (5 ½%) of the City's share of oil from Tract No. 1. This amounts to approximately 2,000 B/D for the seven percent segment and 1,600 B/D for the five and one-half percent segment.

A Notice Inviting Bids for new Crude Oil Sales Contracts to run from September 1, 2004 until March 1, 2006 was published in the Long Beach Press Telegram on June 16 through June 18, 2003, and sent to all known interested parties. Bids were received and opened on July 30, 2003. Exhibit A, attached hereto, shows the results of the bidding.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Fiscal and legal reviews of the submitted bid material were done by the Commission and City of Long Beach Auditing and Legal Units respectively. Based on the results of these reviews, the highest responsible bidder(s) have been identified on Exhibit A, attached hereto. Staff recommends awarding of the new Crude Oil Sales Contracts for Tract No.1, Long Beach Unit, Wilmington Oil Field, Los Angeles County, to the highest responsible bidder(s) identified on Exhibit A, attached hereto.
