GENERAL LEASE - PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT:

City of Isleton
P. O. Box 716
Isleton, California 95641

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, city of Isleton, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Proposed construction of a public fishing pier with a tour boat landing and guest dock, and proposed public side-tie guest dock.

LEASE TERM:

20 years, beginning February 2, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant owns and has a right to use the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. The city of Isleton desires to develop and upgrade the waterfront area adjacent to the Old Town Historic District. The proposed riverfront project, which extends from River Mile 17.5 to 17.85, on the left bank of the Sacramento River within the Isleton City Limits, has two major elements: Phase I a fishing pier and tour boat access center; and Phase II the Old Town Historic District boater-visitor access and public river walk. Phase I of construction, which is funded, only involves the fishing pier, tour boat landing and guest dock and related upland improvements. The City has

not yet contracted for any tour boat operations and will not be charging rental for tour boat use. Phase II of construction involves the side-tie public guest dock. The guest dock will allow transient overnight mooring. No fee is anticipated. However, the City may install a donation box at the site to apply towards ongoing routine maintenance of the facility. No boat storage will be allowed onsite. Garbage disposal and pickup will be provided by the City in the upland service area as use warrants.

- A Section 401 Water Quality Certification has been issued by the Regional Water Quality Control Board for this project.
- 4. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for this project by the city of Isleton. The California State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document.
- A Mitigation Monitoring Program was adopted by the city of Isleton.
- 6. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.


