## RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

#### APPLICANT:

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Patricia A. Sherrow 2915 Calariva Drive Stockton, CA 95204

## AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Calavaras River, near the city Stockton, San Joaquin County.

## **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of an existing floating boat shed, pilings and walkway.

#### LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning March 8, 2004.

### **CONSIDERATION:**

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

## **SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:**

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

## OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

On March 8, 1994, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease 1. to James R. Caldwell. The upland property was subsequently deeded to Patricia A. Sherrow. Patricia A. Sherrow is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease. Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because the applicant is a natural person who has improved the littoral land with, and uses the upland for, a single-family dwelling.

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2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905(a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

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
