AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, near the city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing floating boat dock, gangway, stairway and cables.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning June 01, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in an amount no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On February 12, 1997, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with Stephen M. and Denise M. Launey. The upland property was subsequently deeded to Darryl D. and Anna M. Williams. Darryl D. and Anna M. Williams are now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because the applicants are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.

2. 
