TERMINATION OF PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT AND ISSUANCE OF A NEW GENERAL LEASE - PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT:

County of Sacramento Department of Regional Parks, Recreation and Open Space 3711 Branch Center Road Sacramento, California 95827

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Tide and submerged lands in the Sacramento River, city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Partial removal, relocation, reconstruction, and the continued use and maintenance of a boat ramp, boarding dock, abutment, piles, and bank protection.

LEASE TERM:

21 years, beginning July 1, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Applicant has a 10-year lease, beginning July 1, 2000, with the State of California, Department of Transportation for the uplands and therefore has the right to use the uplands adjoining the lease premises. The lease with the State of California, Department of Transportation expires June 30, 2010, and may be renewed for three additional five (5) year terms.

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
- 2. On October 3, 1972, the Commission authorized Public Agency Permit No. 4703 with the County of Sacramento. That permit will expire on December 20, 2021. The current facility is to be replaced because its location and position causes eddies in the water near the ramp and leads to deposition of silt, which restricts its use by boaters. The current Public Agency Permit will be terminated effective June 30, 2004, and replaced with a General Lease Public Agency Use with a term that coincides with the term of the lease with the State of California, Department of Transportation for the uplands.
- 3. An Initial Study/Negative Declaration was prepared for the proposed project and was approved by the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors on April 3, 2001. That project consisted of removal and replacement of an existing boat launch ramp, abutment, piles, floats and slope protection. As a result of subsequent consultations with permitting agencies, the proposed project was modified. A Revised Initial Study Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and approved by the Sacramento Board of Supervisors on February 3, 2004, for the revised project. The majority of the design and construction will remain the same. The proposed changes to the boat ramp include a decrease in the angle of the boat launch from the shore, a decrease in the length of ramp material extending into the river and the addition of a boarding dock. The California State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document.
- 4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

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

PROJECT LOCATION:

The project is located on the east bank of the Secramento River at the Elichorn Bridge where I-5 crosses the River. The site is located on the west side of Gerden Highway south of the Elichorn Bridge at the intersection of North Bayou Road and the Garden Highway within the North Natomas community of Sacramento County.

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

The proposed project consists of <u>partial</u> removal and replacement of an existing boat launch ramp, abutment, plies and she foot wide concrete walk at the Elikhorn Boat Launch Facility. The project includes revisions to the existing parking lot tayout to provide for additional parking spaces, improved circulation and improved security lighting within the facility. Other improvements would include removal and replacement of the existing restroom and construction of a modified path from the boat launch to the restroom to meet with ADA accessibility standards. Additionally, some of the existing tandscaping would be removed and signage added, along with other enciliary items to improve the facility's overall appearance.
