DREDGING LEASE

APPLICANT:

Chevron Products Company 3400 Christie Street Eureka, CA 95501

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Granted sovereign lands, with minerals reserved to the State, located in the city of Eureka, Humboldt County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Maintenance dredge a maximum of 2,000 cubic yards of material from the Chevron Marine Terminal Facility's permanent tee-shaped pier and dock. The dredged material will be disposed of at a private upland disposal site.

LEASE TERM:

1 year, beginning July 1, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

Royalty to be \$0.25 per cubic yard.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. A Mitigated Negative Declaration, dated January 2004(SCH# 2004012096), was prepared and adopted for this project by the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation, and Conservation District. The California State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document.
- 2. A Mitigation Monitoring Program was adopted by the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation, and Conservation District.

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3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

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
AUTHORIZATION:

AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF A MAINTENANCE DREDGING LEASE TO CHEVRON PRODUCTS COMPANY BEGINNING JULY 1, 2004, FOR A TERM OF 1 YEAR, FOR DREDGING A MAXIMUM OF 2,000 CUBIC YARDS FROM THE CHEVRON MARINE TERMINAL FACILITY'S PERMANENT TEE-SHAPED PIER AND DOCK LOCATED IN THE CITY OF EUREKA, HUMBOLDT COUNTY AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT A AND B ATTACHED AND BY THIS REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF. DREDGED MATERIALS WILL BE DISPOSED OF AT A PRIVATE UPLAND DISPOSAL SITE. SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS; ROYALTY TO BE \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD.

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
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
