#### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, near the city of Sacramento, Sutter County.

#### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Construction, use, and maintenance of a floating boat dock with two jet ski ramps, walkway, and anchor cables.

#### LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning August 1, 2004.

#### CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

#### **SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:**

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905(c)(1).



## Site Plan


