GENERAL LEASE - INDUSTRIAL USE

APPLICANT:

SeaWest WindPower, Inc. 1455 Frazee Rd., #900 San Diego, CA 92108

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Approximately 80,000 square feet of State School Lands located in Section 16, T.16S., R.6E., SBBM, in the vicinity of Boulevard, San Diego County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Installation and operation of not more than two (2) meteorological masts equipped with wind monitoring equipment. Each mast shall be limited to 165 feet in height and each mast site shall occupy no more than 40,000 square feet of surface area.

LEASE TERM:

3 years, beginning September 1, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

\$20,000 in Year One, \$10,000 in Year Two, \$10,000 in Year Three.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance: Liability insurance with coverage of not less than \$1,000,000.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

Public Resources Code: Division 6, Parts 1 and 2; Division 13. California Code of Regulations: Title 2, Division 3; Title 14, Division 6.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. At its meeting on June 7, 2004, pursuant to Calendar Item 36, the Commission authorized staff to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) for a new wind monitoring lease on 640 acres of State School Lands located in San Diego County. The RFP was issued on June 9, 2004. Both the prior Calendar Item and the RFP also included a provision, upon the termination of the wind monitoring lease, for an option for the winning bidder of said lease to apply for an exclusive lease of the subject property for the purposes of operating a wind powered electrical generating facility. Any application for such a facility will be brought to the Commission for its consideration following the completion of the appropriate environmental documentation.
- 2. Pursuant to the terms of the RFP, a duly appointed review panel reviewed and evaluated the proposals received in response to the RFP.
- 3. On July 15, 2004, staff announced its intention to award the wind monitoring lease to the highest qualified bidder for the proposed project, SeaWest WindPower, Inc.
- 4. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the provisions of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 6: Information Collection; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905(e)(5).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, sections 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

5. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6370, et seq. Based upon staff's consultation with persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion the project, as proposed, is consistent with the use classification.

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


