RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Bayless Conley and Janet D. Conley

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Huntington Harbour, Huntington Beach, Orange County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

The continued use and maintenance of an existing boat dock and access ramp.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning August 17, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- On August 22, 1990, the Commission approved a ten-year Recreational Pier Lease for a boat dock to Jane W. Edgerton, Trustee of the Edgerton Family Trust. Subsequently, Lessee sold the littoral parcel in 1992. It appears that the littoral parcel was sold again in 1993, 2000, and 2002. The lease expired August 21, 2000. The littoral parcel was deeded to the Applicants on November 10, 2003. The Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with and use the upland for a single-family dwelling. Applicants are now applying for a new Recreation Pier Lease.
- Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA 2. Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the

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staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
