DREDGING LEASE

APPLICANT:

Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation and Conservation District PO Box 1030 Eureka, CA 95501-1030

And

City of Eureka 531 K Street Eureka, CA 95502

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Legislatively granted sovereign lands, with minerals reserved to the State, in Humboldt Bay Harbor and city of Eureka.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Maintenance dredge a maximum of 433,180 cubic yards, from ten (10) city of Eureka waterfront sites, as well as the Harbor District's Woodley Island Marina, as shown in Exhibit A, to maintain the area at its permitted depths to allow proper function and for safe navigation of fishing, research and recreational craft over the course of ten years. Disposal of dredged material to be located at State-owned sovereign land along the tidal/surf zone along the Pacific Ocean shoreline of the Samoa Peninsula, Humboldt County.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning December 1, 2004, through November 30, 2014.

CONSIDERATION:

No royalty will be charged for disposal of dredged material, as project will result in a public benefit. Dredged material may not be sold.

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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation and Conservation District is the trustee of the legislatively granted sovereign lands, pursuant to Chapter 1283, Statutes of 1970, and as amended, with minerals reserved to the State.
- 2. City of Eureka is the trustee of the legislatively granted sovereign lands pursuant to Chapter 82, Statutes of 1857, and as amended, with minerals reserved to the State.
- 3. A Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation Monitoring Program were prepared and adopted for this project by the Humboldt Bay Harbor, Recreation and Conservation District and the city of Eureka. The California State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document.
- 4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq.
- 5. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF A DREDGING LEASE TO HUMBOLDT BAY HARBOR, RECREATION & CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND THE CITY OF EUREKA BEGINNING DECEMBER 1, 2004, FOR A TERM OF 10 (TEN) YEARS, FOR MAINTENANCE DREDGING A MAXIMUM OF 433,180 CUBIC YARDS FROM TEN (10) CITY OF EUREKA WATERFRONT SITES, AS WELL AS THE HARBOR DISTRICT'S WOODLEY ISLAND MARINA, AS SHOWN IN EXHIBIT A, TO MAINTAIN THE AREA AT ITS PERMITTED DEPTHS TO ALLOW PROPERY FUNCTION AND FOR SAFE NAVIGATION OF FISHING, RESEARCH AND RECREATIONAL CRAFT. DISPOSAL OF DREDGED MATERIALS TO BE LOCATED AT STATE-OWNED SOVEREIGN LAND ALONG THE TIDAL/SURF ZONE ALONG THE PACIFIC SHORELINE OF THE SAMOA PENINSULA,

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HUMBOLDT COUNTY. NO ROYALTY SHALL BE CHARGED FOR DISPOSAL OF DREDGED MATERIAL, AS THE PROJECT WILL RESULT IN A PUBLIC BENEFIT. DREDGED MATERIAL MAY NOT BE SOLD.

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
