### **GENERAL LEASE - RECREATIONAL USE**

### **APPLICANTS**:

Anthony P. Demattei and Gail J. Demattei

### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Tide and submerged lands in the Sacramento River, Rio Viento Campground, Sherman Island, Sacramento County.

### AUTHORIZED USE:

Construction, use, and maintenance of three proposed pedestrian windsurfing access ramps.

### LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning December 1, 2004.

### **CONSIDERATION:**

\$102 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

### SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$500,000.

### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- The three pedestrian access ramps are to be used for access into the water by campers and windsurfers at the Rio Viento Windsurfing Resort.
- 3. The Army Corps of Engineers has issued a Letter of Permission 200300778, which includes completed Section 7 endangered species consultations from the National Marine Fisheries Service (151422SWR00SA9187 (August 04, 2004), and U.S. Fish and Wildlife

Service, 1-1-04-F-0233 (August 13, 2004). The California Regional Water Quality Control Board issued Certification WDID#5A34CR00126 and Reclamation Board issued Permit #17728.

4. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA under the general rule that the CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The staff believes, based on the information available to it, that there is no possibility that this project may have a significant effect on the environment.

Authority: Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061 (b) (3).

5. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.




