East Bay Regional Park District 2950 Peralta Oaks Court Oakland, CA 94605

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Tide and submerged lands in the San Joaquin River, near the city of Antioch, River Mile 7.6, Contra Costa County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing fishing pier.

LEASE TERM:

25 years, beginning July 17, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On July 17, 1979, the Commission authorized a General Lease Public Agency Use with the East Bay Regional Park District. That lease expired on July 16, 2004. The East Bay Regional Park District has applied for a new lease.




