GENERAL LEASE - PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT:

City of Rio Vista One Main Street Rio Vista, CA 94571

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.33 acres, more or less, of tide and submerged lands in the Sacramento River, city of Rio Vista, Solano County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

The continued use and maintenance of an existing public fishing pier and water quality monitoring station.

LEASE TERM:

25 years, beginning April 1, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On April 1, 1979, the Commission authorized a General Lease Public Agency Use with the city of Rio Vista and the Department of Fish and Game, Wildlife Conservation Board. That lease expired on March 31, 2004. The Wildlife Conservation Board no longer is responsible for the use and operation of this facility. The city of Rio Vista has applied for a new lease.


