This Calendar Item No. <u>C22</u> was approved as Minute Item No. <u>22</u> by the California State Lands Commission by a vote of <u>3</u> to <u>d</u> at its <u>129 04</u> meeting.

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RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Don R. Galindo Jr. and Lisa M. Galindo

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River at Grand Island, near the city of Rio Vista, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

The construction, use and maintenance of a new double-berth floating dock, debris diverter, pilings, gangway and stairs.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning December 1, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants own the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of

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Regulations, section 2905 (c)(1).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.






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Location Map



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
