GENERAL LEASE - RECREATIONAL USE

APPLICANT:

Cynthia Caulk

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.07 acre, more or less, of tide and submerged lands in the bed of Steamboat Slough, at Grand Island, near Walnut Grove, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing floating boat dock, gangway, pilings, galvanized cable and concrete boat launch ramp.

PREVIOUS LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning July 11, 1992.

PROPOSED LEASE TERM:

Ten Years, beginning July 11, 2002.

CONSIDERATION:

FLOATING DOCK, GANGWAY, PILINGS, AND GALVANIZED CABLE: No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 6503.5.

CONCRETE BOAT LAUNCH RAMP:

\$85.00 per annum with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent on each fifth anniversary of the beginning date of the lease.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance for a combined single limit coverage of no less than \$500,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

Applicant owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises. 1.

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- On July 11, 1992, the Commission authorized issuance of Lease No. PRC 5910.1, a General Lease Recreational Use, to Cynthia Caulk for the continued use and maintenance of an existing boat dock, gangway, pilings, galvanized cable and concrete boat launch ramp. Cynthia Caulk is now applying for a new General Lease Recreational Use. The concrete boat-launch ramp is in disrepair at this time. However, the proposed lease provides the Lessee, either repair the boat launch ramp to the satisfaction of the Commission or remove it no later than July 11, 2007.
- 3. The Lessee will notify the Commission 30 days prior to the repair or removal of the concrete boat launch ramp and include a description of how the work will be accomplished for the Commission's review. Such review will ensure that any work done instream or affecting the slough will be done in conformance with work windows and other requirements of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, NOAA Fisheries, California Department of Fish and Game, and other regulatory agencies with jurisdiction, e.g., the Central Valley Water Quality Control Board.
- 4. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA under the general rule that the CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The staff believes, based on the information available to it, that there is no possibility that this project may have a significant effect on the environment.

Authority: Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061 (b) (3).

5. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.



AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO CYNTHIA CAULK OF A GENERAL LEASE-RECREATIONAL USE, BEGINNING JULY 11, 2002, FOR A TERM OF TEN YEARS, FOR AN EXISTING FLOATING DOCK, GANGWAY, PILINGS, GALVANIZED CABLE AND CONRETE BOAT LAUNCH RAMP AS REPRESENTED ON THE LAND SHOWN ON EXHIBIT A ATTACHED AND BY THIS REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; CONSIDERATION: FLOATING DOCK, GANGWAY, PILINGS AND GALVANIZED CABLE: NO MONETARY CONSIDERATION PURSUANT TO PUBLIC RESOUCES CODE SECTION 6503.5; CONCRETE BOAT LAUNCH: \$85.00 PER ANNUM WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIFFERENT RENT ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE BEGINNING DATE OF THE LEASE; LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR A COMBINED SINGLE LIMITED COVERAGE OF NO LESS THAN \$500,000.

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
