RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Frances B. Nelson, David D. Bohannon, II and Robert Webster, Trustees of the David D. Bohannon and Ophelia E. Bohannon Revocable Living Trusts dated February 3, 1972 and amended and restated on October 22, 1988

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Tahoe Pines, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing previously authorized pier as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning August 10, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants own the upland property adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. The Commission previously authorized the issuance of a Recreational Pier Lease to the Applicants. That lease has expired and the Applicants are now applying for a new lease for the existing pier. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.

3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
