RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANT:

Donald George Ferguson

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, adjacent to the Garden Highway, city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenace of an uncovered single-berth floating boat dock, ramp, two-pile dolphin, and piling.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning December 8, 2005.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. On May 9, 1988, the Commission approved a Recreational Pier Permit to Robert H. Zimmerman for one boat dock. That lease expired and the upland was subsequently deeded to the Applicant, who is now applying for a Recreational Pier Lease. Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because he is a natural person who has improved the littorial land with, and uses the upland for, a single-family dwelling.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under


