RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANT:

Carol Dalton

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Napa River, near the city of Napa, Napa County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an uncovered floating boat dock, walkway, and ramp as shown on Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning October 12, 2006.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant owns the upland property adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On October 17, 1995, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with Jonathan and Donna Lee Moore. That lease expired on June 30, 2005. The upland property ownership has since transferred to Carol Dalton, who is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease. Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because she is a natural person who has improved the littoral land with, and uses the upland for, a single-family dwelling.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the

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staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

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

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
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
