RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Dirk Mellema and Joann Mellema, as Trustees of the Dirk Mellema and Joann Mellema 1979 Trusts dated April 30, 1979

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Donner Lake, near Truckee, Nevada County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier and the retention of two existing boat hoists as shown on Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning October 1, 2006.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- Applicants own the upland adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On March 23, 1989, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with Dirk Mellema and Joann Mellema. That lease has expired and the Applicants are now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease for an existing pier, previously authorized by the Commission, and the retention of two boat hoists, not previously authorized by the Commission.
- 3. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for a

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single-family dwelling.

4. **PIER:** Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

5. **BOAT HOISTS**: Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (c)(1).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

6. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.


