CONSIDER ACCEPTANCE OF LEASE QUITCLAIM DEED AND TERMINATION OF GENERAL LEASE - RIGHT OF WAY USE

LESSEE:

Delta Gas Gathering, Inc. 2981 Gold Canal Drive Rancho Cordova, California 95670

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.55 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in the San Joaquin River (Stockton Deep Water Ship Channel), between Roberts Island and Rindge Tract, near the city of Stockton, San Joaquin County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Installation of a six-inch diameter welded steel natural gas pipeline.

LEASE TERM:

20 years, beginning April 9, 2002.

CONSIDERATION:

\$190 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability Insurance:

Combined single limit coverage of \$1,000,000.

Bond:

\$10,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Lessee had the right to use the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On April 9, 2002, the Commission authorized a 20-year General Lease Right of Way Use to Delta Gas Gathering, Inc. for the installation of a

horizontal directionally drilled six-inch diameter welded steel natural gas pipeline crossing underneath the San Joaquin River (Stockton Deep Water Ship Channel), between Roberts Island and Rindge Tract, near the city of Stockton, San Joaquin County.

- 3. The Lease contained the condition that the pipeline construction would be completed by April 9, 2005. However, the natural gas pipeline was never installed. Based on the economic infeasibility of proceeding with an amendment to the lease and other circumstances, Delta Gas Gathering, Inc., does not want an extension of the construction deadline and requests the termination of the Lease.
- 4. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15060 (c)(3), the staff has determined that this activity is not subject to the provisions of the CEQA because it is not a "project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.
