### RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

#### **APPLICANT:**

Shirlee M. Queirolo, Trustee of the Queirolo Family Trust U/T/D March 8, 1993, and Shirlee M. Queirolo, Trustee of the Queirolo Family Marital Deduction Trust dated March 14, 2000

## AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near South Lake Tahoe, El Dorado County.

#### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier and one mooring buoy as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

#### LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning May 24, 2005.

#### **CONSIDERATION:**

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

#### **SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:**

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant owns the upland adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On October 17, 1995, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with Joseph Betheford Queirolo and Shirlee Mae A. Queirolo. That leased expired on May 23, 2005. The upland property ownership has since transferred to Shirlee M. Queirolo, Trustee of the Queirolo Family Trust U/T/D March 8, 1993, and Shirlee M. Queirolo, Trustee of the Queirolo Family Marital Deduction Trust dated March 14, 2000. The Applicant is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.

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- 3. Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicant is a natural person who owns the littoral land and uses the upland for a single-family dwelling.
- 4. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

5. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

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
