APPLICANTS:

William J. Lyons, Jr. and Suzanne L. Lyons

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Meeks Bay, El Dorado County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance for an existing pier, boat lift and two mooring buoys as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning June 30, 2007.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants own the upland adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On August 26, 1997, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with William J. Lyons, Jr. and Suzanne L. Lyons. That lease will expire on June 29, 2007. Applicants are now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.
- 3. The Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.
