# LESSEES:

John H. Broughton and Grayce A. Broughton

# AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in Steamboat Slough, adjacent to 3427 Snug Harbor, near the town of Walnut Grove, Solano County.

#### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of an existing uncovered floating boat dock, deck, gangway and bank protection as shown on Exhibit A.

#### **LEASE TERM**:

10 years, beginning December 1, 2005.

#### CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends that the rent be continued at \$50 per year, effective December 1, 2010.

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- On December 1, 2005, the Commission authorized a General Lease Recreational and Protective Structure Use to John H. Broughton and Grayce A. Broughton for a term of 10 years. This lease will expire on November 30, 2015.
- The uncovered floating boat dock and gangway are exempt from consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5. However, the deck does not qualify for rent-free status because it was not constructed for the mooring and docking of boats. A small portion of the deck extends over sovereign land.
