**REVISION OF RENT**

**LESSEE:**

Delta Gas Gathering, Inc.

**AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:**

0.62 acres, more or less, of tide and submerged land in the Sacramento River, near the town of Courtland, Sacramento and Yolo Counties.

**AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of an existing six-inch diameter welded steel natural gas pipeline.

**LEASE TERM:**

20 years, beginning August 15, 1996.

**CONSIDERATION:**

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends that the rent be revised from \$206 per year to \$321 per year, effective August 15, 2011.

**OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

1. On August 21, 1996, the Commission authorized a General Lease – Right-of-Way Use to Delta Gas Gathering, Inc. (DGG) for the construction of a six-inch diameter welded steel natural gas pipeline buried beneath the bed of the Sacramento River using horizontal direction drill construction. The lease will expire August 14, 2016
2. This pipeline extended DGG's gas gathering system from Yolo County next to the Hudson #1 well (off South River Road) on Merritt Island to a point on Randall Island in Sacramento County. The pipeline is classified as a rural gathering line. The pipeline was last inspected September 29, 2010, and as a result, no repairs or modifications were made within the lease area.
