REVISION OF RENT

LESSEE:

Newport Federal, a California Corporation

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in Lake Tahoe, adjacent to 741 Lakeview Avenue, city of South Lake Tahoe, El Dorado County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of one mooring buoy.

LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning December 3, 2007.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that the State may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff conducted a review of the rent under this lease and recommends rent be revised from \$340 per year to \$377 per year, effective December 3, 2012.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- On December 3, 2007, the Commission authorized a General Lease Recreational Use to Newport Federal, a California Corporation, for a term of 10 years. The Lease will expire on December 2, 2017. Staff conducted the rent review called for in the lease and recommends that the rent be increased.
- 2. The staff recommends that the Commission find that the subject revision of rent does not have a potential for resulting in either a direct or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and is, therefore, not a project in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
