CONSIDER ACCEPTANCE OF THE FULL QUITCLAIM DEED OF A NEGOTIATED SUBSURFACE (NO SURFACE USE) OIL AND GAS LEASE NO. PRC 9008.1

LESSEE:

Summit Exploration (California), LLC

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 9008.1 contains 5 acres of sovereign land underlying Tyler Slough, bounded by Georgiana Slough on the northwest and Snodgrass Slough on the southeast in the South ½ of projected Section 35 in Township 5 North, Range 4 East, and in the North ½ of projected Section 2 in Township 4 North, Range 4 East MDM, in the Walnut Grove area of Sacramento County, California (Exhibit A, attached).

BACKGROUND:

The Commission authorized the negotiated subsurface (no surface use) Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 9008.1 (Lease) to Summit Exploration (California), LLC, on August 14, 2012 (Calendar Item C87, August 14, 2012). Under the terms of the Lease, the Lessee is required to pay an annual rental of \$50 per acre (\$250 for 5 total acres) and to commence drilling operations on the leased lands within 5 years. A review of the Commission's files reveals that no wells have been drilled on or into the leased lands, no default payment exists on the Lease, and that the Lessee has complied with all applicable laws and Lease provisions and has paid all rentals.

On March 30, 2017, the Commission's Long Beach office staff received the document PRC 9008.1 Quitclaim Deed for State Oil and Gas Lease (Exhibit C, attached). This document was dated March 30, 2017, and quitclaims to the State all of the Lessee's rights, title and interest in the leased lands as described in the attached Exhibit A to Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 9008.1.

STAFF ANALYSIS AND RECOMMENDATION:

Public Resources Code section 6804.1 and Lease paragraph 9 permit the Lessee to make, at any time, a written quitclaim of all rights under the lease. The quitclaim is effective when it is filed with the State subject to the continued obligation of the lessee and its surety to pay all accrued rentals and royalties and

to abandon all wells drilled on the leased lands. Specifically, section 6804.1 of the Public Resources Code indicates that "the Lessee may at any time make and file with the State a written quitclaim or relinquishment of all rights under the Lease or of any portion of the Lease". The above lease was issued to Summit Energy on August 14, 2012 with a 5-year primary term (that is they had 5 years to commence drilling or the lease would expire under its own terms). No drilling or any other activity has been done on this lease since its issue and Summit Energy has no current plan to develop the lease. At all times, the Lessee has conformed to all lease provisions and all rent has been paid to date. Staff therefore, recommends acceptance of Summit Energy's request to quitclaim the lease.

- 1. This action is consistent with Strategy 1.1 of the Commission's Strategic Plan to deliver the highest levels of public health and safety in the protection, preservation, and responsible economic use of the lands and resources under the Commission's jurisdiction.
- 2. Acceptance of the quitclaim deed is not a project as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act because it is an administrative action that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.


