REVISION OF RENT

LESSEE:

Delta Yacht Club

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in the San Joaquin River, adjacent to Assessor's Parcel Number 129-120-01, near Stockton, San Joaquin County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing floating boat dock, walkway, and bank protection.

LEASE TERM:

20 years, beginning September 16, 2000.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that the Commission may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease and recommends that rent be revised from \$5,267 per year to \$5,538 per year, effective September 16, 2017.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The Lessee owns the upland adjoining the Lease Premises.
- On April 24, 2001, the Commission authorized a General Lease Recreational and Protective Structure Use (<u>Item 36, April 24, 2001</u>). The lease will expire on September 15, 2020. The docking facilities are for the private use of the members of the Delta Yacht Club.
- 3. This action is consistent with Strategy 2.2 of the Commission's Strategic Plan to ensure timely receipt of revenues and royalties from the use and development of State lands and minerals.
- 4. Approving the revision of rent is not a project as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act because it is an administrative action that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.
