The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of the act cited in the title hereof is amended to read:

Conditions
of cession

Sec. 3. Said cession is made upon the express condition that the corporate authorities of said city shall not sell the property ceded; but said property, and any parts thereof, together with any wharves, docks, piers and other structures or improvements thereon, and so much of the uplands abutting thereon as, in the judgment of the city council, or other governing body, of said city, may be necessary for the proper development and use of its waterfront and harbor facilities, may be leased for a period not to exceed fifty years.
