#### **ARTICLE 5.1 MARINE TERMINAL PHYSICAL SECURITY**

##### **UPDATE OF INITIAL STATEMENT OF REASONS**

As there were no comments or objections received during the 45-day public comment period, therefore no modification to the original proposal of the Commission to repeal Article 5.1 of Title 2, Division 3, Chapter 1 was necessary. The Commission has determined that an update to the Initial Statement of Reasons is therefore not necessary.

##### **SUMMARY AND RESPONSE TO COMMENTS RECEIVED DURING THE 45-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD OF APRIL 6, 2018, THROUGH MAY 21, 2018.**

No written or oral comments were received from the public by the Commission staff, therefore, no responses are provided.

##### **ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED**

The Commission has determined that no alternative it considered or that was otherwise identified and brought to its attention:

- Would be more effective in carrying out the purpose for which the repeal of Article 5.1 regulation is proposed
- Would be as effective as and less burdensome to affected private persons than the proposed repealed regulation, or
- Would be more cost-effective to affected private persons and equally effective in implementing the statutory policy or other provisions of law.

The proposed repeal of this regulation does not impose mandate on any local agencies or school districts.
