ASSESSING RISK OF VESSELS ARRIVING IN CALIFORNIA

- Vessel arrivals in CA pose a risk to marine resources
- To be cognizant of low performing vessels and operating companies
- Reduce pollution causing incidents


THE NEED

- Quantify the risk imposed by each vessel and operating company
- Develop a database to systematically accomplish objective
- Focus OSPR's resources on low performers

OBJECTIVE

- Break the Error Chain of events that cause pollution incidents
- Target low performing vessels and operators
 - Increase outreach efforts
 - Compliance inspections
 - Oil transfer monitorings
 - Increased scrutiny
 - Visual presence
