**NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSIDER AN ADDENDUM  
TO A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION**

A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) has been prepared by the California State Lands Commission (CSLC), as lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Pub. Resources Code, § 21000 et seq.), in response to an application submitted by Chevron Pipe Line Company (CPL) to amend General Lease – Right-of-Way Use (PRC 3277.1) to install a new horizontal directional drilled (HDD) 8-inch-diameter refined petroleum products pipeline and abandon-in-place the existing 8-inch-diameter pipeline under Grizzly Slough; all other terms and conditions of the lease would remain in effect without change. The Addendum is in compliance with the requirements of CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15000 et seq.).

**Project Title:** Mallard Farms Pipeline Replacement Project

**Project Location:** Suisun Marsh and Honker Bay, Solano County

**Project Description:** Modifications to the Project would include relocating the North Work Area to the north of Grizzly Island Road in an area with greater soil stability. As a result, the revised Project also includes the replacement of a 1.7-mile segment of pipeline via HDD. Onsite activities are currently scheduled to begin in May 2017 and completed in July 2017, with offsite mobilization and demobilization occurring a few weeks before and after this period.
