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EXPLANATIONS

The City and County of San Francisco contain 20,000 acres, eight miles long, east and west, six miles wide, north and south. Latitude, 37 deg. 45 min. Longitude, 122 deg. 30 min. west.
Hair-line circles from Ferry Landing, foot of Market Street.
Irregular Black Line near the Bay, separating the City from the original water-front line.
Parks, squares, and Government Reservations are marked with green tints, and are lettered as follows:
Ranches on Nevada Hill, Rancho, Green and Redwood, high at the Bay. All even numbers on the right and odd on the left hand side from above of building.
About 100 numbers to each full block.
Street Car Lines are marked with red lines, principal streets upon which they run, and route is indicated on each line by system of numbered blocks.
